

HORSEMANSHIP SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION

The 'hands on' program at Woodline Equestrian Ltd, is designed to develop a well rounded 'horseman'. We emphasize safety while conducting all these areas. Each day, students are involved in learning how to catch, groom and tack up their horse as well as 2 hours of riding lessons daily. The students will learn about general horse care, (the feeding program, mucking a stall, instruction on grooming and tacking), the parts of a horse, proper names of the grooming equipment, awareness of different bits, the parts of a bridle and saddle and how to care for the equipment. The colors, markings and breeds of different horses and general first aid/health care of horses. They will also meet a farrier and watch a shoeing demonstration, if time permits. There will also be horse related games and crafts. At the end of the week, we invite the parents, family members and friends to come watch what the campers have learned throughout the week, with a fun horse show and to meet their child's equine partner. After the demonstration, we will wrap up the camp with a BBQ for everyone.

Here are the weeks available to sign up for 2012:

The times are as follows:

Monday to Thursday 9:00am – 4:00pm

Friday 9:00am – 1:00pm (Demonstration & BBQ day)

Campers can be dropped off as early as 8:30am and be picked up as late as 4:30pm. If your child needs to be picked up or dropped off at different times than stated, please contact us to arrange. There will be an additional charge for this service. (\$10/day)

*Our camps are mainly geared towards riders with little or no riding experience. However we break the riding portion into smaller groups to accommodate different riding levels and ages. We accept riders that are 7 years old and up.

**The cost is \$400 + gst for the week. There is a \$150 non refundable deposit that must be paid when registering your child to hold the spot. The balance (\$270) can be paid on the first day of camp. We accept payment by VISA, debit and cheques are payable to Woodline Equestrian Ltd.

**** **Things you will need for camp:** Campers will need to bring a lunch Monday – Thursday as well as plenty of snacks and drinks. There is a microwave and fridge available for lunches that need it.

All riders will need boots with a heel and pants for the riding portion of the camp. A change of clothes for when they are not taking their riding lessons (shorts, etc.) are permitted. Optional but recommended is bug spray and sunscreen. Woodline provides all of the equipment needed for the horses and will have helmets available for the riders to borrow for the week. Having your own helmet is encouraged but not mandatory. Bike helmets are not permitted for use for riding. If you are interested in purchasing a helmet, we recommend Greenhawk tack shop near the Deerfoot Inn Casino:
