

## **SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION**

Students will receive a basic introduction to English riding. The morning will involve learning how to catch, groom, and tack up their horse as well as a daily lesson. The students will learn about general horse care, (feeding program, mucking a stall, instruction on grooming and tacking, etc). They will also meet a farrier and watch a shoeing demonstration. The afternoons will be full of horse related games, crafts, and lessons. At the end of the week we invite the parents, family members and friends to come watch what the campers have learned throughout the week and meet their equine partner. After the show we will wrap up the camp with a BBQ for everyone.

**Campers can be dropped off as early as 8:30am and be picked up as late as 4:30pm. If your child needs to be picked up/dropped off at different times than stated please contact us to arrange. There will be an additional charge for the service.**

\*Our camps are mainly geared towards riders with little or no riding experience. However we break the riding portion onto smaller groups to accommodate different riding levels and ages. We accept riders that are 7 years old and up.

\*\* The cost is \$400 +GST for the week. There is a \$150 non refundable deposit that must be paid when registering you child to hold the spot. The balance (\$270) can be paid on the first day of camp. We accept payment by visa, debit and cheques are payable to Woodline Equestrian Ltd.

\*\*\*Things you'll need for camp: Campers will need to bring a lunch Monday – Thursday as well as plenty of snacks and drinks. There is a microwave and fridge available for lunches that need it. All riders will need boots with a heel and pants for the riding portion of the camp. A change of clothes for the afternoon (shorts, etc.) is permitted. Optional but recommended is bug spray and sunscreen. Woodline provides all of the equipment needed for the horses and will have helmets available for the riders to borrow for the week. Having your own helmet is encouraged but not mandatory. Bike helmets are not permitted for use for riding. If you are interested in purchasing a helmet we recommend the Lammles in Shawnessy and the Greenhawk tack shop near the Deerfoot Inn Casino.
